



County of Cumberland ASH Branch Annual Pointscore Awards

All County of Cumberland ASH Branch Subscription Holders are eligible to enter the Annual Point Score Awards. The competition runs for results earned between 1 August and 31 July. Participants are to submit their **best ten* (10) ASH performances** from events of the following standard:

- Sydney Royal Show qualifying Agricultural Shows or from a non-agricultural (Breed or Hack) Show
- ASHS Branch, State & National Shows
- Royal Shows
- Double Points are awarded for the County of Cumberland ASH Branch Show

The following awards will be announced at our Branch Presentation night:

- High Point Led Junior Horse
- High Point Led Senior Horse
- High Point Junior Hack
- High Point Senior Hack
- High Point Junior Working
- High Point Senior Working
- High Point Junior Versatility
- High Point Senior Versatility
- High Point Youth Horse – Rider under 13 years
- High Point Youth Horse – Rider 13 & under 18 years

Conditions & Definitions

- Points are collected for 1 horse / 1 owner for the point score year, with the owner to be a current subscription holder of the County of Cumberland ASH Branch.
- Points for the High Point Youth Horse are to be collected for a horse & rider combination from youth events only. Youth events are not included for the open horse point scores.
- Points are to be received by the point scorer by 31 August. You will receive a confirmation email of the receipt of these points. If you do not receive this, please follow up your nomination.
- A separate performance sheet is to be completed for each horse & each section entry.
- Junior Horse - Horses 3 years & under for the competition year
- Senior Horse – Horses 4 years & over for the competition year
- Versatility events include Dressage, Campdraft, Station Horse & Utility events.
- Points will be counted from the open events only (Novice and/or other restricted events are not counted)
- Points will be awarded **for your top 10 ASH events** as follows: 1st = 3 points, 2nd = 2 points, 3rd = 1 point, Champion = 2 points, Reserve Champion = 1 point, Supreme = 1 point plus* points for the following placings can be will be counted additional to the top 10 events: Champion / Reserve Champion / Supreme points where the event is:
 - an ASHS State or National Show
 - the Sydney Royal Show
 - the County of Cumberland ASH Branch showunless those results were already counted in the top 10 events.
