CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All people entering the grounds, competitors and handlers do so voluntarily. Neither the organizing committee nor The Australian Stock Horse Society Limited accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to the horses, riders, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
2. **Membership & Registration Numbers** must be supplied on purchase of ring tickets. All competitors must be members of the Australian Stock Horse Society (or pay a ASHS Day Membership)
3. All horses – except for those ridden by youth competitors under 13 years – must be registered with the Australian Stock Horse Society Ltd and membership papers must be produced on request, or you will be ineligible to compete.
4. Protests must be lodged on the day in writing with a \$40.00 fee, which will be refunded if the protest is upheld.
5. The committee has the right to delete, defer to alter the program of events on the day.
6. All colts & stallions when tied up must wear a collar and be double tied. All colts & stallions must be handled and ridden by a person 18 years & over.
7. Handlers & competitors must be suitably attired according the ASHS Handbook – no joggers permitted.
8. Horses must be bridled and saddled when being ridden on the grounds.
9. All competitors under 18 years must wear an Australian Stock Horse Approved equestrian helmet in all events including led, junior handler classes and when riding on the grounds at all times.
10. The CCASH committee have the right to alter any of the prizes nominated on this program without notification.
11. Classes will not be held for any competitor.
12. **ENTRY MONIES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE ... UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.**
13. Definitions:
 - A **Novice** horse is a horse that has not won more than 3 novices or 1 open *class at any show, open gymkhana* or similar event, except wins in youth, consolation or restricted age classes. Any Horse that wins an Open Championship or Supreme regardless of age will no longer be a Novice Horse.
 - **Intermediate Rider** – rider over 18 yrs who has not won an open ridden event at an Agricultural, State, National or Royal show. Intermediate Rider **MUST** wear a compliant helmet. Winners of the Intermediate Rider classes are not eligible for the Open Champion, but a Intermediate Rider Champion to be judged prior to the Supreme Ridden Horse of the Show.
 - **Hack series and Working series** - there are 2 patterns for each series and the top 10 riders for each series will complete the final pattern. Pre-entry fee is \$40 per horse per series. Entry on the day is allowed but will incur an additional fee of \$10. No refund of entry fee.
 - **Heritage Horse Classes** – Winners of the Heritage classes are not eligible for the Open Champion, but a Heritage Horse Champion to be judged prior to the Supreme Ridden Horse of the Show.

HIGH POINT YOUTH AWARDS

- One Horse – One Rider for all the point scores.
- Points will be gained in ring events & station horse. No points awarded from sporting events or challenges:
 - HP1 - **Camelot Horse Rugs** High Point Youth on an ASH - Rider under 13 years (rug)
 - HP2 - **Camelot Horse Rugs** High Point Youth on an ASH – Rider 13 & under 18 years (rug)
 - HP3 - **Ultimate Horse Shop** High Point Youth on an unregistered horse – Rider under 13 yrs (rug)

FUTURITY AND MATURITY ENTRIES

- Entry fees must be enclosed with the entry. No entries will be taken on the day.
- Horses must compete at the age they turned on 01 August 2019.
- All futurity horses will be inspected on the morning of competition – **registration papers must be attached with entry.**
